#### **EDUCATION**

Engage in at least one anti-racism or implicit/unconscious bias program this year.

#### LEGISLATION

Contact at least one elected official each at the local, state and federal levels to encourage them to support anti-racist legislation and policies and pledging to vote towards racial justice in elections this year.

#### INCLUSION

Encourage decision makers and hiring managers to recruit, hire and promote women of color to leadership positions in the non-profit and philanthropic sectors.

#### ACTION

Develop a personal or professional racial equity goal to accomplish each year. WOC will help you determine this goal and will follow-up with you as an accountability partner in this work.


